- I. The meeting convened at 7:05 p.m.

- III. CDG and NB made a site visit to Carey Rd. to look at the proposed wetlands crossing. They did not locate any wetlands. The ZBA site visit is scheduled for Sept. 4 at 4 p.m.
- IV. A letter to NHDES, to be filed in support of Robert Banker and Charity Brown, was approved.
- V. SCA work on Children's Woods is due to begin Sept. 21. Funds have been allocated to meet the requirements of the grant. CDG will confirm the submission of the agreement.
- VI. The property known as The Jaffrey Poor Farm has a 10 year Historic Easement on the barn. MG will speak to the owner, Doug Cook, regarding the benefits of additional easements.
- VII. The pine trees at the edge of Children's Woods have been cut. The bill for the work has not yet been submitted.
- VIII. Advertisement of the educational program scheduled for Sept. 11, Raptor Rapture, was approved.
- IX. The Minutes of Conservation Commission Meetings have been put on the town website.
- X. The letter to neighbors of Cheshire Pond Conservation Area (CPCA), reminding residents that motorized vehicles are not permitted on the property, was approved.
