a) **TEAM Jaffrey**

“Riverfest: A Community Event” on Saturday, July 25, 2015. Events planned include Musical Chairs on Main Street, craft fair, live music, children’s art and games, library book sale, as well as entertainment, food and family-friendly fun. Many other community organizations will be setting up and inviting event goers to learn about their mission, drawing thousands to downtown Jaffrey! This event serves to connect Jaffrey residents, local businesses, and visitors while strengthening and celebrating our community’s businesses and organizations.

We ask the Board to consider the following:

- 1) Permission to use the bandstand and town common the day of the event
- 2) Permission to erect a temporary sign on the common and the Riverwalk fence to advertise the event (with fee waived)
- 3) That a vendors license be granted to TEAM Jaffrey for the day with fee waived
- 4) Permission to block the entrance to the town parking lot (at Main Street) the day of the event. (pending TD Bank approval)
- 5) Permission to set up a craft fair on the library lawn the day of the event. (We already have library approval approval)
- 6) Permission for a “Bike and Buggies Parade” at 10am from St. Pat’s School parking lot to the Blake Street parking lot (pending partnership, escort, and “safety detail” with Jaffrey Police Department and Jaffrey Fire Department.
- 7) Permission to close Memorial Drive (directly in front of the Police Station) from 7 am Saturday until 9 pm Saturday to facilitate the event. (With Chief Oswalt’s approval and notifications to tenants and businesses in Abbott Building)
- 8) Permission to close Main Street between Rt 202 and School Street from 8 am to 4 pm (pending DOT approval) **note, DOT requires local approval prior to submitting their application- we will need a record of approval to submit.*
