§ 155-01 Purpose

The purpose of this ordinance¹ is to update and consolidate in one document the various chapters in the *Code of the Town of Jaffrey* that deal with vehicular parking in the town.

§ 155-02 General Information

This document is designed to replace the following chapter of the above-mentioned *Code*:

Chapters 185-11; 185-12; 185-13; 185-14; 185-21; 185-22; and 185-23

Where applicable, every attempt was made to incorporate provisions of *Revised Statutes Annotated (RSA)* 265:69 through *RSA* 265:72.

§ 155-03 Time Limit Parking

No person shall park a vehicle for longer than two (2) hours in any of the marked parking spaces on the following described streets or parts of streets:

Main Street	Both	From School Street to Blake Street	7:00 a.m. — 7:00 p.m. Monday through Saturday

Goodnow Street	Both	East Side: Beginning 25 feet northerly of the intersection with Main Street and continuing 135 feet northerly West Side: Beginning 25 feet northerly of the intersection with Main Street and continuing 211 feet northerly	7:00 a.m. — 7:00 p.m. Monday through Saturday
North Street	East	East Side: Beginning 33 feet north of the intersection with Main Street and continuing 87 feet northerly	7:00 a.m. — 7:00 p.m. Monday through Saturday
Blake Street	West	From Main Street to last marked parking space	7:00 a.m. — 7:00 p.m. Monday through Saturday

No person shall park a vehicle for longer than four (4) hours in any of the marked parking spaces on the following described areas:

Blake Street parking lot

§ 155-04 Parking Prohibited During Certain Hours/Seasons

- A) No person shall park any vehicle on any street in the Town of Jaffrey between the hours of 11:00 p.m. and 6:00 a.m. from November 1st to April 15th. This prohibition also applies to all Town-owned parking lots, with the exception of designated parking spaces in the Blake Street parking lot.
- B) There shall be no parking on any street in Jaffrey on Thursday evenings from 11:00 p.m. until Friday morning at 6:00 a.m. to allow for the cleaning of the town’s streets. This also applies to all Town-owned parking lots, with the exception of designated parking spaces in the Blake Street parking lot.
- C) There shall be no parking on the following streets during the time periods listed:

§ 155-05 Parking Prohibited At All Times

No person shall stop, stand, or park a vehicle, except temporarily for the purpose of and while actually engaged in loading or unloading of passengers or merchandise:

- A) On the roadway side of any vehicle stopped or parked at the edge or curb of a street (*i.e.* no “double” parking);
- B) On a sidewalk;
- C) Within twenty (20) feet of a crosswalk at an intersection;
- D) Within fifteen (15) feet of a hydrant;
- E) In front of a public or private driveway;
- F) At any place where official signs prohibit stopping or parking (School Street “No Stopping/ Standing” restrictions do not allow for the temporary loading or unloading of passengers or merchandise);
- G) On any street or parts of streets with white “fog lines” where the vehicle would extend over the white line into the travel lane;
- H) In any parking place, whether public or private property, specifically designated for a person with a walking disability by means of a sign as required by *Revised Statutes Annotated (RSA) 265:73-a* stating that the space is reserved for a person with a walking disability or displaying the international accessibility symbol, unless that person has special numbered plates, decals, or a card issued by another state or country displaying the international accessibility symbol and that person who qualifies for the plate, decal, or card is being transported to or from the parking place; or
- I) Upon any of the following described streets or parts of streets:

Peterborough Street	West	From Bourgeois Street to Main Street
Main Street	Both	Any area that is not a marked parking space from Charlonne Street to Blake Street
North Street	East	Beginning at a point 120 feet from the intersection of Main Street northerly to Nutting Road
North Street	West	Beginning at the intersection with Main Street northerly 162 feet
Blake Street	East	From old depot building to Main Street

§ 155-06 Additional Parking Regulations

The following additional parking regulations also apply:

- A) Except as otherwise provided in this ordinance, every vehicle stopped or parked upon a roadway where there are adjacent curbs shall be so stopped or parked with the right-hand wheels of such vehicle parallel to the right-hand curb, or, if upon a roadway where there are no curbs, said vehicle shall be so stopped or parked with the right-hand wheels of such vehicle parallel to the right-hand side of the traveled portion of the way.
- B) Every vehicle stopped or parked upon a one-way roadway shall be so stopped or parked parallel to the curb or edge of roadway in the direction of authorized traffic movement with its right-hand wheels within twelve (12) inches of the right-hand curb or edge of the roadway or its left-hand wheels within twelve (12) inches of the left-hand curb or edge of the roadway. No person driving or in charge of a vehicle shall permit it to stand unattended without first stopping the engine, locking the ignition, removing the key and effectively setting the brake thereon, and, when standing upon any grade, turning the front wheels to the curb or side of the way.

§ 155-07 Penalties

Any person found to be in violation of any of the regulations contained in this ordinance will, as a minimum, be subject to receiving a parking ticket. In addition, penalties and fines may be imposed for specific violations as follows:

- A) Any vehicle parked in violation of Paragraph IV above shall be towed to garages at the expense of the owner(s) of such vehicle, and/or said owner(s) shall be fined an amount not less than ten dollars (\$10.00) and not to exceed twenty-five dollars (\$25.00).
- B) A person who violates the provisions of subparagraph V. H shall be fined a minimum of fifty dollars (\$50.00).
